NOTICE OF PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) will hold a Public Consultation Meeting to discuss the proposed revisions to the Title V permit for the Palos Verdes Landfill Repower Project. The Palos Verdes Landfill is located at 25706 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rolling Hills Estate and is operated by Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts (LACSD).

The LACSD, the landfill owner/operator, is proposing to replace two existing boilers used for combustion and destruction of landfill gas with new state of the art equipment consisting of eight new microturbines, a new fuel cell system and a new flare, as well as to modify the existing landfill gas collection system. The existing flares will remain on site as a backup. The AQMD has evaluated the permit applications and made a preliminary determination that the proposed equipment will meet all applicable requirements of air quality rules and regulations and issued a public notice on December 31, 2009 indicating its intent to revise the Palos Verdes Landfill's Title V permit.

A 30-day public comment period regarding the intent to issue "Permits to Construct" and revised Title V permit for the above proposed project was completed as of January 30, 2010 during which time the AQMD received a request for a public hearing and written comments. As a result of this request and comments received, the AQMD has decided to hold a Public Consultation Meeting. At the Public Consultation Meeting, AQMD will present a general overview of the proposed permit revisions and offer the public an opportunity to provide additional input and to ask questions about the proposed permit revisions.
